2010

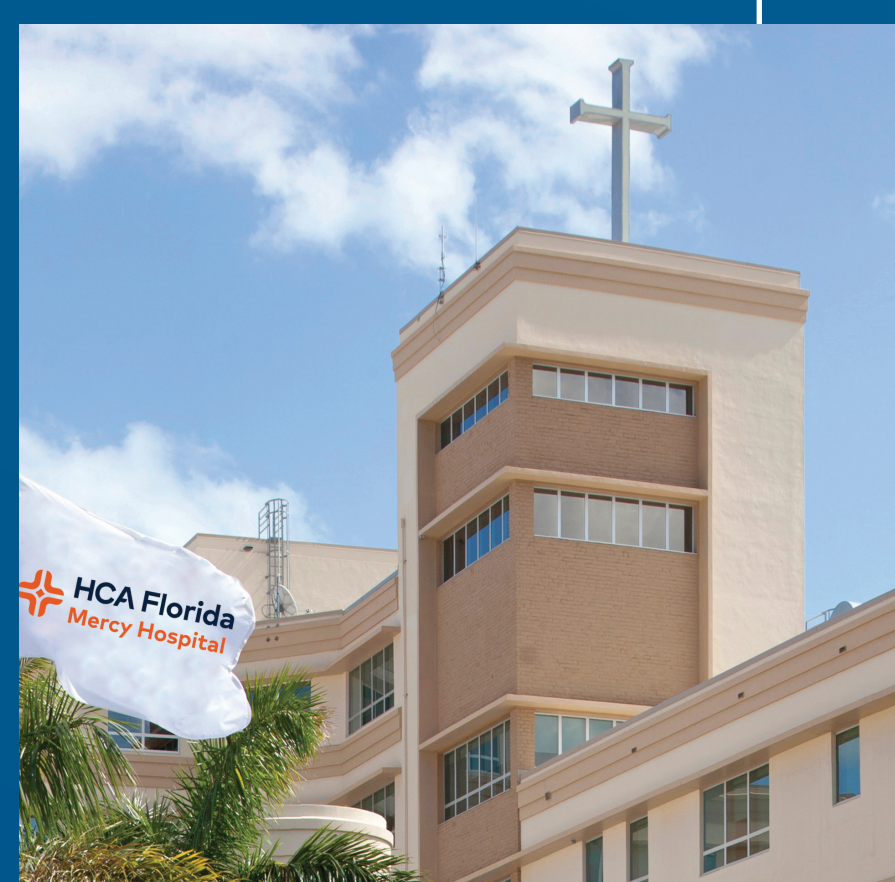
Launched the first hospital-based CyberKnife Robotic Radiosurgery system in Miami - a non-invasive alternative to surgery for treatment of both cancerous and non-cancerous tumors anywhere in the body.



2011



Built a partnership that supported its excellence and mission of service to the community while remaining faithful to its Catholic identity, leading to its acquisition by HCA.



2016

Invested over \$30 million to upgrade the Carroll Tower, encompassing all medical-surgical beds.



2019

Expanded inpatient rehabilitation with a \$25 million investment, enabling the hospital to provide comprehensive therapy to more patients recovering from illnesses, injuries, or surgeries.



2024

Invested \$13 million to establish comprehensive stroke capabilities with the addition of an advanced biplane interventional imaging system, enabling minimally invasive procedures to treat stroke, carotid artery disease, and cerebral aneurysms.



2025

Invested nearly \$100 million in capacity projects to support the community, including operating rooms, inpatient rehab beds, and Women's Services – encompassing Labor & Delivery, Postpartum Care, and the Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit.
