

Safeguarding community members' hearts

Through our ongoing "Getting to the Heart of Stroke™" partnership with the American Heart Association, we continue to use education and various initiatives to help community members keep their hearts healthy while avoiding heart disease and stroke.

- Communities with Heart has expanded to locations at Kansas City Public Library, Mid-Continent Public Library, Johnson County Library in Kansas and other community sites, empowering individuals to manage hypertension through on-site kiosks.

Crush the Crisis keeps unused medications off our streets

Every year, HCA Midwest Health joins HCA Healthcare's nationwide drug take-back day, in partnership with local law enforcement, to collect unused or expired medications. In addition, we also partnered with Heartland Regional Alcohol and Drug Assessment Center to provide community members with naloxone, a drug used to reverse opioid overdoses, and fentanyl test strips.

Protecting youth mental health and wellness

HCA Midwest Health continues identifying ways to further our reach and impact to support the mental well-being of children and adolescents in our community.

- · Partnered with the Girl Scouts of NE Kansas & NW Missouri and the National Alliance on Mental Wellness to host a mental wellness patch workshop for about 100 girl scouts. This program helps girls in 4th grade to 12th grade develop coping skills for stress and learn to seek help when needed.
- · Funded the expansion of EVERFI's interactive mental health and wellness educational course to serve 888 students across 18 Kansas City schools, with more in implementation phases

Quality protocols enhances surgical recoveries

All HCA Midwest Health facilities use enhanced surgical recovery (ESR), multimodal evidence-based treatments that help providers reduce and control patients' surgical pain while also greatly reducing the need for strong pain medications. ESR has proven to decrease surgical complication rates and opioid usage compared to those surgeries not using ESR.

Training tomorrow's care teams

Our commitment to training the next generation of clinical caregivers runs deep, providing students and early career providers with knowledge of the latest therapies and evidence-based practices. Through our Research College of Nursing and robust graduate medical education (GME) program, we are taking a proactive approach.

HCA Midwest Health is improving access to clinical education through a:

- \$34.5 million investment in a new Research College of Nursing facility, which will include a Center for Clinical Advancement that pairs modern education facilities with simulation opportunities
- New pre-licensure nurse apprentice program – the first of its kind in Kansas and in the region – allowing apprentices to earn-and-learn their way to a nursing license
- Expanded clerkships for third- and fourth-year medical students as part of our enhanced six-year partnership with Kansas City University, Missouri's largest medical school
