1981

Mercy Hospital's Latin American Medical Seminar got its start in 1981. Physicians from Latin America and the Caribbean came to Mercy to learn about the latest medical treatments available.



1981

Launched the School of Nursing program.

1990

Celebrated its 40th anniversary with the expansion of its Radiation Oncology Center and updated Women's Pavilion.

1992

In August, the cross which had stood atop the former St. Francis Hospital was lifted by helicopter to Mercy Hospital's roof. Four days later Miami-Dade County was badly battered by Hurricane Andrew, yet the cross remained standing.

1993

The hospital's 20-bed Comprehensive Rehab Unit was established.



1996

Mercy opened its Hyperbaric and Wound Care Center, dedicated to treating patients with acute and chronic wounds, as well as those suffering from decompression sickness.

1999

Mercy opened the Kohly Center for Outpatient Rehabilitation to better serve Miami's soaring need for outpatient rehabilitation services.

2000

Mercy celebrated 50 years of service to the community.
