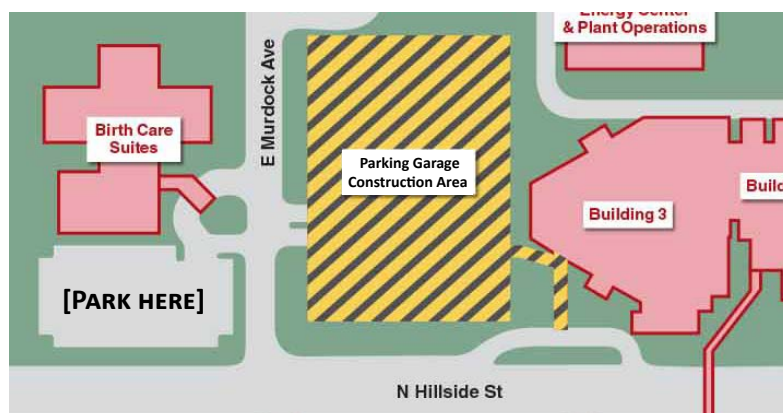
Delivering your baby at Wesley Healthcare

Wesley Healthcare offers two options for delivering your baby. Which is right for you depends on your overall health, potential for complications and physician preference.

Given construction projects currently underway at Wesley Medical Center, it is more important than ever to know ahead of time where you should go when it's time for your baby to be born.

Is your pregnancy considered LOW RISK?

If you have reached 37 weeks gestation without complications, you likely will be eligible to deliver your baby at Wesley Birth Care Suites, 3222 E. Murdock St.

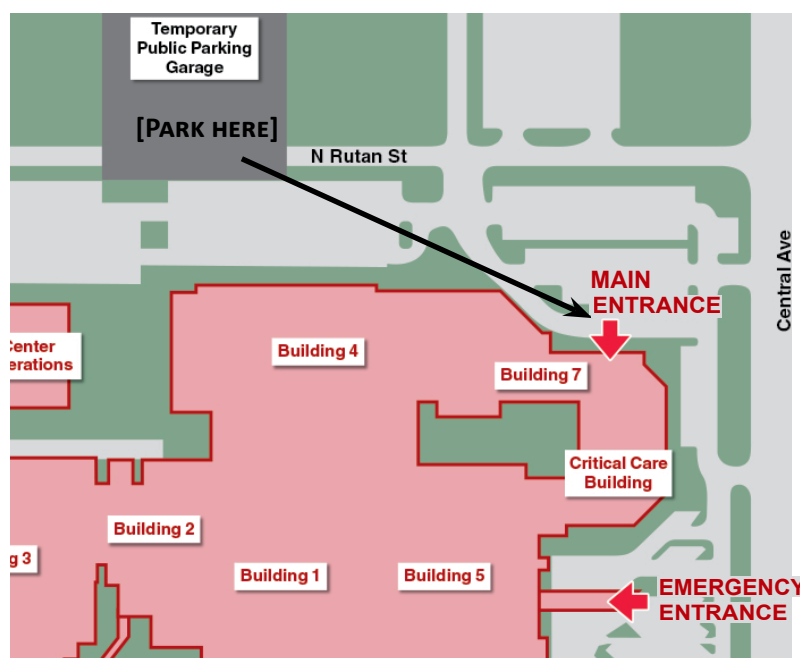


Is your pregnancy considered HIGH RISK?

You should deliver your baby at Wesley Medical Center, 550 N. Hillside St., if you are less than 37 weeks gestation and have any of the following complications:

- Preeclampsia
- Eclampsia
- Hypertension
- Diabetes
- Previous C-section
- Other medical conditions as identified by your physician

If you are not sure where you should go, we will work with you and your physician to determine which facility is right for you.

Directions to Labor and Delivery Unit

During our parking garage construction project, patients at the Wesley Medical Center Labor and Delivery Unit will park in the temporary public parking garage (formerly the employee parking garage) on Rutan Street.
