Maie A. St. John, MD, PhD, FACS



A highly renowned surgeon, scientist and educator, Dr. Maie St. John is Professor and the Chair of the Department of Head and Neck Surgery and Professor of bioengineering at UCLA and is co-director of the UCLA Head and Neck Cancer Program. Her laboratory studies the mechanisms of

tumor progression and metastasis in head and neck cancer and seeks to identify and study novel genes and pathways for future targeted therapies, while actively incorporating the results of their laboratory-based research into the development of novel therapeutics.

Dr. St. John is an outstanding educator who has provided mentorship to numerous trainees, and serves as a member of several prestigious organizations including the Executive Council of the American Head and Neck Society, the Triological Society, American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, American College of Surgeons Board of Governors Advisory Council, American Laryngological Association and Collegium Oto-Rhino-Laryngologicum Amicitiae Sacrum.

Dr. Houlton specializes in head and neck oncology, facial plastics and reconstruction. Upon graduating with honors from the University of Texas Medical Branch, Dr. Houlton completed his residency in head and neck surgery at the University of Cincinnati and fellowship in head and neck oncology/microvascular reconstruction at the Medical University of South Carolina. He is an active member of the American Academy of Otolaryngology, is a fellow with the American College of Surgeons, and is the director of head and neck quality and patient outcomes at the Sarah Cannon Cancer Institute.

Theresa M. Hofstede, DDS, FACP



Dr. Theresa Hofstede is a Professor in the Oral Oncology and Maxillofacial Prosthodontics department at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston. She works very closely with the colleagues in head and neck surgery, plastic and reconstructive surgery and radiation

oncology departments. Dr. Hofstede sees well over 1000 head and neck cancer patients annually and has extensive experience evaluating and managing the oral morbidities of the head and neck cancer patient, before, during and after treatment. She serves as the program director of the oldest U.S. accredited Advanced Education Program in oral oncology and maxillofacial prosthodontics. She is an active collaborator in multiple research projects within the department of head and neck surgery.

Dr. Hofstede has also driven the effort to increase implant placement and rehabilitation in the oncology patient. Her academic foundation is steeped in historical principles, quality in education, diverse cutting-edge technology and nurturing our next generation of leaders in oral oncology and maxillofacial prosthodontics.
