HCA HealthONE, a part of HCA Healthcare, is one of the largest and most comprehensive healthcare systems in the Rocky Mountain region, with more than 170 care sites in the Denver-metro area. We offer services across the continuum of care to meet patients' total healthcare needs. HCA HealthONE includes seven acute care hospitals, a dedicated flagship pediatric hospital, a rehabilitation hospital, CareNow® urgent care clinics, a mental health campus, imaging and surgery centers, doctor practices, home and hospice care and HCA HealthONE AirLife which provides regional critical care air and ground transportation.

Our acute care and pediatric hospitals feature advanced medical technologies and expertise across numerous specialties, including cardiology, oncology, orthopedics, neurosciences, women's health and transplant services. Our commitment to comprehensive care is further exemplified by specialized facilities such as Level I and Level II trauma centers, a certified burn and reconstruction center and the region's largest Level IV neonatal intensive care unit (NICU). HCA HealthONE AirLife extends its reach across a 10-state region, ensuring timely access to advanced care, even in remote areas.

Consistently ranked among the Denver Business Journal's list of top workplaces and top corporate philanthropists in the Denver-metro area, we contributed more than \$1 million through cash and in-kind donations last year alone, along with more than \$400 million in federal, state and local taxes.

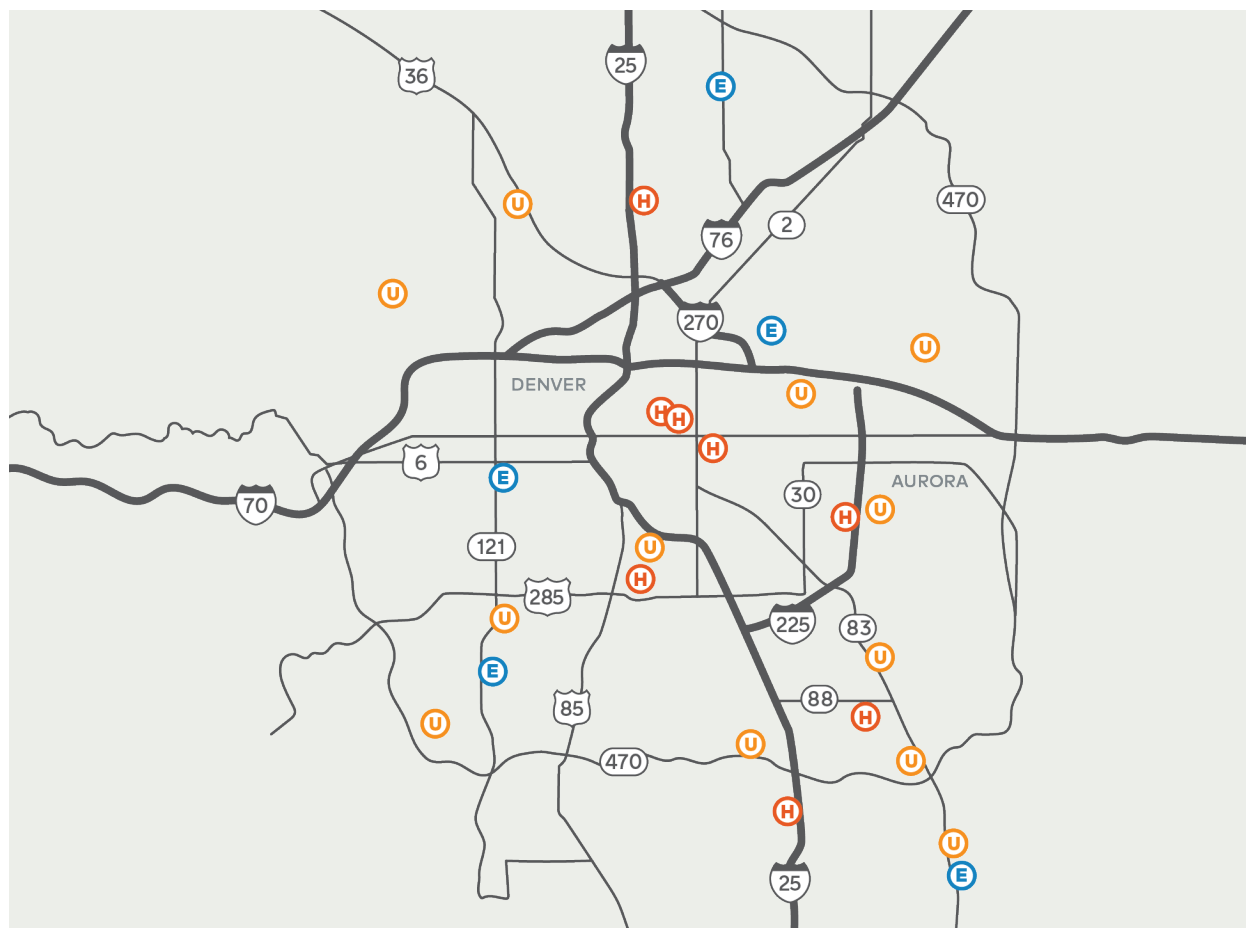

PINC AI and Fortune 15 Top Health Systems

Premier's PINC AI and Fortune named our market the No. 4 large health system in the nation as part of their 15 Top Health Systems 2024 report. This is the fourth time our health systems have been recognized in the 15 Top Health Systems.



PINC AI and Fortune 100 Top Hospitals

Healthgrades

Five HCA HealthONE hospitals received the American Heart Association's Get With The Guidelines - Stroke and Mission: Lifeline achievement awards for demonstrating commitment to following up-to-date, research-based guidelines for the treatment of heart disease and stroke, ultimately leading to more lives saved, shorter recovery times and fewer readmissions to the hospital.



Magnet designation

HCA HealthONE Aurora and HCA HealthONE Rose are designated as Magnet hospitals for nursing excellence by the American Nurses Credentialing Center. Only 10% of U.S. hospitals achieve Magnet designation, the universally recognized gold standard in nursing care.



U.S. News & World Report Best Hospitals

HCA HealthONE Presbyterian St. Luke's, in partnership with the Colorado Blood Cancer Institute and HCA Healthcare Sarah Cannon Cancer Network, was named the No. 1 hospital for cancer care in Colorado and No. 46 in the nation by U.S. News and World Report as part of their 2023-2024 Best Hospitals for Cancer Care program.

Additionally, HCA HealthONE Sky Ridge was named to the 2024 U.S. News Best Hospitals list, ranked as the No. 5 hospital in Colorado and was high performing in nine procedures and conditions.



PINC AI 50 Top Cardiovascular Hospitals

HCA HealthONE Aurora and HCA HealthONE Swedish were identified among the nation's 50 Top Cardiovascular Hospitals according to PINC AI, a brand of Premier, Inc. and reported by Fortune.



Level 1 Children's Surgery Center verification

HCA HealthONE Rocky Mountain Children's at Presbyterian St. Luke's was verified as a Level 1 Children's Surgery Center by the American College of Surgeons Children's Surgery Verification Quality Improvement Program (ACS CSV). They were the first children's hospital in the global HCA Healthcare network to achieve this status.



Burn Center verification

HCA HealthONE Swedish's burn and reconstructive center is a comprehensive program providing burn and reconstructive care for adults and children. Verification by the American Burn Association recognizes the high quality of care we provide to our patients from the time of injury through reconstruction and rehabilitation.



HCA HealthONE Mountain Ridge was recognized by the Lown Institute as one of the most socially responsible hospitals in America, receiving an "A" grade on the 2024-25 Lown Institute Hospitals Index.

Shaping a healthier tomorrow for our community

We actively support the local economy through strategic partnerships with nonprofits and investments in programs that foster well-being and equitable care, shaping a healthier tomorrow.

\$1.84 million HCA Healthcare Foundation grant to launch United for Healthy Starts

Through the HCA Healthcare Foundation's Healthier Tomorrow Fund, we granted \$1.84 million to Mile High United Way to launch United for Healthy Starts. This national collaboration, which also benefits United Way of Metropolitan Dallas, United Way Miami and United Way of Greater Nashville, aims to increase access to social, economic and education support services for families. The initiative seeks to improve family health outcomes through tailored home visitation and wraparound services, strengthening service delivery and innovation. HCA Healthcare and its foundation have a 30-year history of supporting United Way, with more than \$17 million in contributions to improve communities nationwide.

Supporting Denver Inner City Parish to combat food insecurity

Through the HCA Healthcare Foundation, we awarded a \$25,000 Health Equity Catalyst Grant to Denver Inner City Parish to address food insecurity. The grant, funded through the HCA Healthcare Foundation's Healthier Tomorrow Fund, supported the Parish's food pantry program, Greens-N-Grains healthy after-school meal program, and Veggie Rx program, with a focus on healthy food access and nutrition education.

Partnering with AHA for healthier communities

We are partnering with the American Heart Association (AHA) to implement impactful community health programs that address critical needs. These initiatives, benefiting more than 42,000 people annually across 17 sites, focus on controlling blood pressure and improving nutrition security. Key efforts include self-measured blood pressure (SMBP) programs and evidence-based clinical care. In Denver, STRIDE Community Health Centers supported 7,987 hypertension patients, while Lifespan Local & Integrated Family Community Services expanded food access in underserved communities. As a national sponsor of Getting to the Heart of Stroke, we are committed to reducing health disparities and improving cardiovascular outcomes.

"Crush the Crisis" event tackles drug misuse

We collected 2,886 pounds of medication during HCA Healthcare's sixth annual "Crush the Crisis" prescription drug take back day. Top collecting facilities included HCA HealthONE Aurora (861 pounds), HCA HealthONE Sky Ridge (842 pounds), and HCA HealthONE Mountain Ridge (534 pounds). In 2024, HCA Healthcare collected a record 21,137 pounds, bringing the total since 2019 to over 88,600 pounds. In partnership with HCA Healthcare, we leverage data from millions of patient encounters to enhance care and reduce prescription drug misuse through initiatives like Enhanced Surgical Recovery (ESR) and Electronic Prescribing of Controlled Substances (EPCS).



HCA HealthONE food drive provides thousands of meals to Coloradans in need

In 2024, our hospitals joined forces for HCA Healthcare's annual Healthy Food for Healthier Tomorrows food drive, addressing food insecurity in Colorado. Our amazing colleagues donated 5,128 pounds of food to local food pantries. On top of that, volunteers at Food Bank of the Rockies packed pallets of food, providing over 82,000 meals to people in need.

HCA HealthONE Mountain Ridge's monthly food bank also made a huge impact, providing 137,310 pounds of food for 1,934 families and 6,143 individuals in need.

Unit of Distinction

Nine HCA HealthONE units received the 2024 HCA Healthcare Unit of Distinction (UOD) Award. Notably, HCA HealthONE Rocky Mountain Children's at Presbyterian St. Luke's pediatric intensive care unit (PICU) was recognized as the No. 1 Top Ranking Unit in HCA Healthcare for the second consecutive year. The UOD Awards, initiated in 2015 as part of HCA Healthcare's nursing strategy, honor units that excel in advocacy, leadership, consistent nursing practice, operations and leveraging scale to improve care. Units of Distinction represent the top 5% of HCA Healthcare units in specialized areas, while the top 6-10% receive honorable mention designations.

HCA HealthONE Rose's ICU and HCA HealthONE Sky Ridge's PICU received honorable mentions in critical care. In emergency services, HCA HealthONE Centennial's emergency department was a UOD Recipient, and HCA HealthONE Rose's emergency department received an honorable mention. HCA HealthONE Centennial's medical surgical unit was a UOD Recipient in the medical surgical/general category. HCA HealthONE Rocky Mountain Children's 5C neonatal ICU (NICU) received an honorable mention in the neonatal ICU category, while HCA HealthONE Sky Ridge's pediatrics received an honorable mention in pediatrics. Finally, HCA HealthONE Swedish's perinatal unit received an honorable mention in perinatal services.

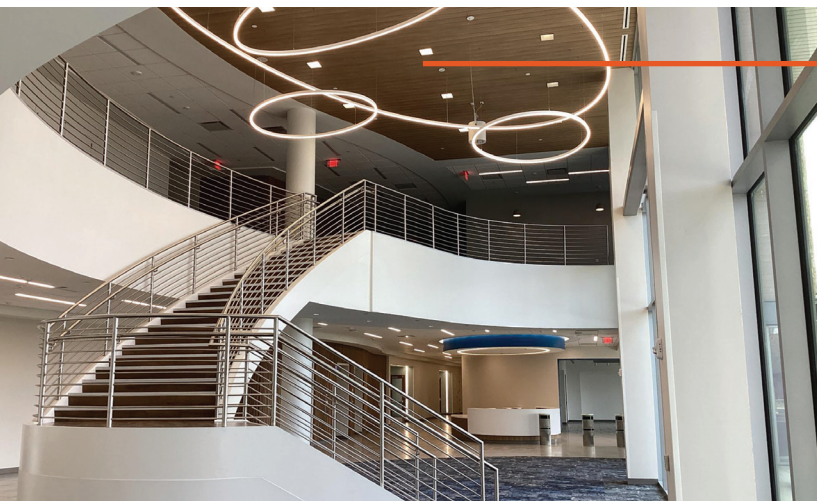
