KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



WILLIAM LYDIATT, MD, EMBA

Professor of Surgery, Creighton University, Clinical Professor of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery, U.S. Naval Hospital, Portsmouth, Virginia Chair, AJCC Head and Neck Core Group, President Elect, American Head and Neck Society

Dr. Bill Lydiatt is Professor of Surgery at Creighton University, Clinical Professor of Surgery UNMC, and is President-Elect of the AHNS. He is Chair of the AJCC 9th Edition Head and Neck Staging panel and a member of the AJCC Editorial Board. He received his BS from Stanford, MD, his Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery Residency from University of Nebraska and his Fellowship in Head & Neck Surgical Oncology from Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, NY. Dr. Lydiatt received his EMBA from the University of Colorado. A former CMO, he has also held multiple VP positions in Medical Affairs, Surgical Services and Chair of Surgery at Nebraska Methodist Hospital. Dr. Lydiatt has a long-standing interest in the prevention of depression in Head & Neck Cancer patients, and the use of the arts to enhance teaching and understanding of the patient experience. He has also written over 150 publications, books and book chapters in the field.



LAWRENCE E. BRECHT, DDS

Director of Maxillofacial Prosthetics, Department of Dental Medicine and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Department of Otolaryngology - Head & Neck Surgery Lenox Hill Hospital, Long Island Jewish Medical Center & North Shore University Hospital - Northwell Health, Adjunct Clinical Associate Professor and Director of Maxillofacial Prosthetics, New York University College of Dentistry - Postgraduate Program in Prosthodontics

Dr. Brecht is currently the Director of Maxillofacial Prosthetics at Lenox Hill Hospital, Long Island Jewish Medical Center and North Shore University Hospital of the Northwell Health System. In addition, he serves as the Director of Maxillofacial Prosthetics in the Postgraduate Prosthodontic Program of NYU College of Dentistry where he is an Adjunct Associate Clinical Professor of Prosthodontics. Dr. Brecht also has the privilege of an appointment in the Department of Head & Neck Surgery at MD Anderson Cancer Center of The University of Texas. For over 25 years, Dr. Brecht was the Director of Dental Services at the Institute of Reconstructive Plastic Surgery at NYU Langone Medical Center with appointments at NYU School of Medicine in the Department of Plastic Surgery and the Department of Otolaryngology/Head & Neck Surgery. Dr. Brecht maintains a private practice in Manhattan limited to Prosthodontics and Maxillofacial Prosthetics. He has authored numerous articles and book chapters on the maxillofacial reconstruction and oral rehabilitation of patients with cancer or craniofacial anomalies. In addition, he is a past-president of the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontics and the American Academy of Maxillofacial Prosthetics (AAMP). He is also a Fellow of the Academy of Prosthodontics as well as the ITI (USA). Dr. Brecht serves as the president of The Maxillofacial Foundation as well as the NextGenFace Foundation.
