- The above rates include OR, PACU, and anesthesia supplies/medications as well as drugs, IV's and oxygen therapy administered while in surgery. The anesthesiologist's charges will be billed separately. Diagnostic testing and prostheses/implants are excluded from the flat rate and will be billed at the

normal rate. Professional interpretation fee for EKG and pulmonary function are not included in the hospital charge. Any other physician fees will continue to be billed separately from the hospital charges. If an outpatient becomes an inpatient the above cited room and care charge will be replaced with the hospital's prevailing room charge. As a hospitalized inpatient, one will also be billed for any other chargeable services and/or supplies received. Multiple procedures done at the same time will be entitled to a 50% discount for the least expense procedure.
